Who May Qualify

Eligible households with uninsured or under-insured losses at a primary residence.



Eligible Expenses

- Certain home repairs
- Essential furniture and household furnishings
- Essential appliances and tools
- Debris removal
- Medical devices
- Essential transportation
- Other eligible disaster-related expenses.



What to do First

If you haven't already, contact your insurance company if you have storm-related damage or losses.



How to Apply

Apply through <https://www.in.gov/dhs>. IDHS will review your application and may request additional information.



This program is separate from FEMA Individual Assistance.



Submitting an application **does not** guarantee assistance. Eligibility and funding amounts are determined through the State Disaster Relief Fund review process.
